## Alzheimer's Awareness Month

Whereas Alzheimer's disease and other forms of dementia affect an estimated 600,000 Canadians and nearly 1 million Canadians will be affected by dementia in less than ten years; and

Whereas nearly 12,000 New Brunswickers are affected by Alzheimer's disease or other forms of dementia; and

Whereas there is no known cure to date for this devastating disease; and

Whereas one in five people living with dementia avoid seeking support for their diagnosis due to stigma;

Therefore I, Judy Wilson-Shee, Mayor of the Village of New Maryland, do hereby proclaim the month of January 2024 as Alzheimer's Awareness Month and encourage the citizens of the Village of New Maryland to become more educated on the profound effects of this devastating disease and to support the Alzheimer Society of New Brunswick.
